

Fire Training Props Available

The Hamilton County Fire Training Calendar consists of FFI & II classes and the Fire Training Props that is/are reserved for an agency. If the calendar <u>DOES NOT</u> list a Fire Training Prop on a particular day, then the prop is available to use for your department. To reserve a Fire Training Prop, please contact Lt. Jody Clift at (423) 209-6900 or *jclift@hamiltontn.gov*. All Fire Training Props will be subject to damage repair by the user. All Fire Training Props will be scheduled, signed out & in through Lt. Jody Clift. All materials and costs will be incurred by each department using a Fire Training Prop.

- DRAGER SYSTEM 64: Live Fire Propane Training Prop: Provides a live fire training scenarios on how to attack and control Propane Tank emergencies. It is a great in-service tool for paid and combination departments. Classroom training (2-4hrs) is required before using this prop. This prop requires 2 HCES Instructors on-site and administer the burns at all times. Class can last 2-4 hours.
- 2.) **Sprinkler Trailer:** Mobile trailer for use of teaching personnel how to control sprinkler heads and riser controls.
 - a. It is a great in-service tool for paid and combination departments
 - b. Can combine classroom with hands-on training. (2-4 hour class)
- 3.) **Forcible Entry Door Simulator**: Mobile door used to teach personnel proper techniques for forcing most type of doors. HCES personnel will deliver, set up & pick up.
 - a. Combines classroom with hands-on training. 2-6 hour training can be achieved with the prop.
 - b. Requires wood to be purchased by the agency/user. NOT FURNISHED BY HCES.
- 4.) <u>Hose Inflator Kit</u>: Used for hose handling. Air bottle supplied air in 2.5 or 1.5 line to inflate hose instead of using water. Great for indoor training with hose handling
- 5.) King Ceiling Prop Simulator: Realistic training for Ceiling Pull/Overhaul and Wall Breaching.
 - a. ½ Drywall, OSB or cement board are material choices for this prop. NOT FURNISHED BY HCES.
 - b. Changeable ceiling obstruction holes for wiring/pipe placement
 - c. Adjustable heights and on wheels
 - d. Can be used indoors or outdoors
 - e. RIT use too

6.) Hydrant and Hose testing kit

- 7.) Smoke Machines: Must replace fluid usage
- 8.) Flash Pans: Used for Fire Extinguisher Training
- 9.) Vent Simulator Kit: Used to teach proper size of hole to cut into roofline
 - a. 2-6 hour training
 - b. Requires some prep work to attach simulator to a 2x6 rafter
 - c. Requires OSB strips. NOT FURNISHED BY HCES
 - d. Requires "trained" personnel to train other personnel on a ventilation saw. NOT FURNISHED BY HCES.
