

Hazmat Team Trucks and Equipment

Truck 1- This is a medium size rescue/squad style truck with a walk-in box. This truck is equipped with multiple types of atmospheric monitoring equipment including radiological monitoring devices. Truck 1 also has a wide array of field sampling equipment including a Hazmat ID Elite (FTIR). The truck is also equipped with specialized plugging, patching, and leak supplies to mitigate highway, rail, and industrial emergencies.

Truck 3- This is a large box style truck with a hydraulic lift gate. This is an all-purpose hazmat truck. We keep everything to handle large scale incidents. PPE, decontamination equipment, spill cleanup supplies, and a hand tools.

Truck 4 & 5- These 4X4 F-350 trucks with slide out beds are used as quick response truck to handle small spills. We also utilize these trucks to pull our utility trailers for UTV's and river boom responses.

UTV's- The team has two UTV's that are used primarily for special events in the county. They are also used for storm response to get to areas that can't be reached by other vehicles. These vehicles have also been utilized for search and rescue operations and wildfires.

Boom Trailers- We have two trailers loaded with a combined 2000 feet of river boom. The team is the primary response agency for the region for spill incidents in waterways. This specialized boom can be deployed to contain spills in the waterways to a confined area for easier cleanup and mitigation.

Weather Response Trailer- This cargo trailer is equipped with chain-saws, pole saws, generators, tarps, and tools to assist in the event we have severe storm damage in the community. The hazmat team will come in and provide this valuable resource to the community to speed up response to areas with damage.
